Entry Fees: \$10.50 per event. Relay and Skins events are free.

Age: Age is at Day 1 of the meet (Saturday 3rd August).

Entries Close: Entries open Monday 1 July at 8 am. Entries close Monday 29 July at 10 pm.

Entries: This meet is open to all swimmers in the SNZ database. The 200 Fly (Top 10 female, Top 10 male) and 400 Free (Top 20 female and Top 20 male) events are Open events. Clubs will be notified of the eligible swimmers after entries have closed.

Entry Method: All clubs and swimmers can enter through SNZ Fastlane. See below for information on entry for Relays and Skins events. Any queries, please email mtswimrecorder@gmail.com

Events: This is a designated meet. Electronic timing will be used. Meet to be swum under SNZ/Fina rules and local rules, with local rules taking precedence. All events are timed finals, with results declared for male and female in the following age groups: U12, U14, U16 and 16 and over.Prize money is awarded for male and female in each age group: \$7 for 1st place, \$5 for 2nd place, \$3 for 3rd place.

Para Athlete Events: Athletes who hold a Para Classification are eligible to participate in this programme and will be seeded amongst able-bodied athletes on the basis of entry times. It is the responsibility of the athlete with a disability (or their Team Manager) to inform the Referee before they swim of their IPC Classification and to supply the Referee with their IPC Classification Card. The Referee will use their best efforts to judge the swim under the applicable IPC rules.

<u>Relay Events</u>: Relays can be entered via SNZ Fastlane or submitted 15 minutes before the start of Session 1. The Meet Director reserves the right to limit the number of relay teams per club so that there are no more than three heats per age group. Relay prize money will be awarded for the following age groups: 13&U, 14&O.

Skins Events: To be eligible for Skins events, swimmers must be entered in at least 3 individual events, including the 100 IM. Skins participants will be selected based on their rank in the 100 IM (Event 1). There will be 5 races swum on 2:30, with the two slowest swimmers being eliminated after each race. Race 1 is Fly, Race 2 is Back, Race 3 is Breast, Races 4 and 5 are Freestyle.

Prize Money: Prize money is to be collected by Team Managers only, and must be signed for upon receipt.

Amendments: LVWASC and MMSC reserve the right to amend session start times if needed.

Protests: These must be lodged under SNZ Rules on the Swimming New Zealand Protest Form. Protests can be lodged only by the duly appointed Team Manager on the appropriate form, and must be accompanied by the correct fee of \$100.

Meet Requirements

- Scratching refunds will be given if a medical certificate is presented no later than 48 hours after meet end.
- NT's must be provided by the swimmer's coach or club.
- Reseeding or the combining of heats will be at the discretion of the Referee or the Meet Director.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Regulations.
- The results will be posted as soon as possible at the conclusion of the event.
- · Over-the-top starts and the FINA One Start rule apply.
- All spectators will be charged an entry fee by Bay Venues.
